6	Shooting by public 2	CM O P S	2	2	4		✓	Instructor/coach to assess individual for potential problems arising from loose clothing/long hair/earrings etc. Issue safety equipment, as appropriate (brace and chest guards, elastic bands for tying back hair, request removal of earrings/piercings etc)	RI
7	Shooting 3	CM O P S	2	2	4		✓	Instructor coach to assess individual for suitable bow/arrows etc, in relation to size, age, fitness. Check vision and eye dominance.	RI
8	Shooting 4	CM O P	3	3	9		✓	When appropriate for completion/clearance of designated shooting zone, instructor/coach to accompany participant to waiting line. Provide additional instruction on safety and basic Rules of Shooting. As and when directed by appointed Field Captain, accompany participant to shooting line, provide instruction on safe use of equipment, allow participant to shoot under strict guidance and supervision. Clear shooting line, on completion of normally six arrows. Accompany participant to safe zone and return of equipment. Arrows will not be collected by participants.
